## Fun Facts About Our Cows

In the survey you let us know that you want to know more about the cows. Here are some fun facts.

- A cow carries her baby for 9 months. It's the only pregnancy that is the same as humans.
- At our farm, we have Holstein cows which are white with black spots. A Holstein's spots are unique like finger prints. No two Holsteins have the same spot pattern.
- A Holstein baby calf will weigh about 85 pounds when it is born. A Holstein cow weighs between 1400 and 1500 pounds. The bulls can weigh more than a ton.
- A Holstein cow, in production, can eat about 120 pounds of feed and drink as much as 70 gallons of water per day.
