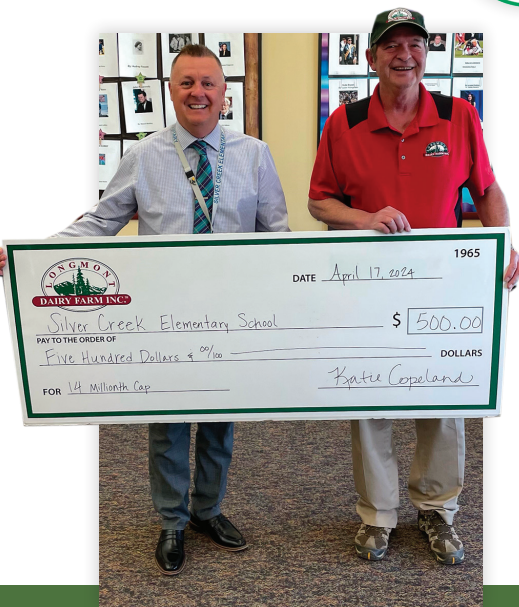


## Over Fourteen Million Caps Collected!

Congratulations to Silver Creek Elementary School in Thornton! They turned in the 14 millionth cap in the Milk Caps for Moooola program. In honor of this achievement, we celebrated with a milk and cookies party in a 5th grade classroom with their teachers, principal, and representatives from the Dairy. Silver Creek Elementary has been part of the program for ten years, earning almost \$4,000 in that time. Donations to local schools have now exceeded \$700,000!

Through Milk Caps for Moooola, the Dairy donates five cents for each bottle cap collected by students at participating schools. Schools may use the funds to benefit their students any way they choose. Most schools use their "Moooola" for field trips, sports or playground equipment, art supplies, or iPads. One school bought a parachute for P.E. classes.

# MOOO RECIPES



A Dad-favorite that's fun for Father's Day and ready in just a few minutes! This creamy bacon cheese dip includes chopped bacon, cream cheese, BBQ sauce, shredded cheddar cheese, and green onions.

## Creamy BBQ Bacon Cheese Dip

3 slices bacon, crisply cooked, coarsely chopped    ½ c. Georgia Boys BBQ Sauce  
8 oz. plain Philadelphia Cream Cheese, softened    ½ c. shredded Tillamook Cheddar Cheese  
2 Tbsp. sliced green onions

Set aside two tablespoons of the chopped bacon for garnish. In a food processor or blender, combine cream cheese, BBQ sauce, cheddar cheese, and remaining bacon. Process or blend on high speed until all ingredients are well combined.

Garnish the dip with green onions and reserved bacon. Serve with crackers or veggie tortilla chips.
