Ellie's Frozen Berry Lemonade

12 oz. Longmont Dairy Regular or Raspberry Lemonade 3/4 c. berries of choice 1-2 c. ice to your liking

Blend all ingredients to desired consistency and enjoy! Makes about 2 servings.

This simple way to make homemade ice cream calls for just three ingredients (plus any desired mix-ins) and is ready in just a few hours. Top with seasonal fruit, or for extra flavor, swirl in some fruit sauce.

Easy No-Churn Ice Cream



Strawberries Blueberries Mint leaves (optional)

In a large bowl whip the cream to stiff peaks being careful not to over-whip.

In another large bowl, whisk the vanilla into the sweetened condensed milk. Gently fold in the whipped cream, slowly incorporating the two mixtures, keeping it light and aerated.

Transfer to a metal bread pan or paper container and freeze for 4-6 hours or overnight.

Serve topped with strawberries and blueberries and garnish with mint leaves, if desired.
