This seasonal treat is great with tortilla chips as an appetizer, and is also really good on fish, pork, or chicken. Makes 6-8 servings.

Fresh Peach Salsa

1 lb. tomatoes 1 medium onion 1 bell pepper, seeded 2 jalapenos, seeded 1½ lbs. peaches ½ bunch cilantro 2 Tbsp. lime juice 1½ tsp. salt or to taste

 $\ensuremath{\mathcal{V}}_{\!\!4}$ tsp. freshly ground black pepper or to taste

Chop tomatoes and put in a large bowl.

Finely chop onion, and seeded bell pepper and jalapeños, and transfer to the bowl. To dice the peaches, do not peel, and cut into slightly larger pieces. Transfer peaches to bowl.

Chop cilantro and add with lime juice, salt, and pepper. Fold together until mixed and enjoy with tortilla chips, or on fish, pork, or chicken!


