# MOOO RECIPES



The term “fool” may have French roots meaning to mash or crush. With four simple ingredients and only 15 minutes, this delicious dessert gets you the perfect Valentine’s Day treat! Serves 4 to 6.

## Raspberry Fool

- 1 c. Longmont Dairy whipping cream
- 1 Tbsp. sugar
- 1/2 tsp. vanilla
- 2 c. frozen raspberries
- 1/2 c. sugar

Whip the whipping cream, one tablespoon sugar, and vanilla. Set aside. In a food processor, blend the frozen raspberries and half cup sugar. Once the raspberries have been blended, fold them into the whipping cream with a spatula. Evenly distribute the dessert between 4-6 dessert cups or fancy glasses. Serve immediately or refrigerate until you are ready to enjoy! Substitute with strawberries, blackberries, or even a mix of berries.
