16 Million and Counting!

Since 2012, our Milk Caps for Mooola program has given Colorado schools a simple, fun way to raise money—just by collecting Longmont Dairy milk caps! What began with 25,000 caps the first year has grown to an average of 45,000 caps collected every week during the school year, with more than 400 schools now participating. Started by our longtime Community Service Director, Gary Schlagel, and guided by him until his retirement in June 2024, the program has become a much-loved tradition. Many schools have shown their creativity with fun, eye-catching collection bins that encourage families to join in.

This year, we celebrated a major milestone: 16 million milk caps collected. **Donations to** local schools have reached \$800,000-all thanks to the small but mighty milk cap!

Load this versatile dish with any combination of vegetables you like. Add chopped parsley, chives, or basil. Top with feta, goat cheese, or cheddar cheese, and a sprinkle of bread crumbs.

Hearty Veggie Casserole

1 head broccoli, cut into florets 1 head cauliflower, cut into florets black pepper 1 red bell pepper, sliced 1 yellow bell pepper, sliced 1 c. cherry tomatoes, halved 1/4 c. olive oil 1 tsp. Italian seasoning

1 green Spanish onion, chopped 1 c. chopped spinach leaves, optional 4 large Eggland's Best eggs 1/2 c. Longmont Dairy milk 1/4 c. all-purpose flour

In a large bowl, combine broccoli, cauliflower, bell peppers, cherry tomatoes, olive oil, Italian seasoning, chopped green Spanish onion, 1/2 teaspoon salt, and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Toss to coat evenly. Spread the vegetables in a 9x13" baking dish.

In a medium bowl, whisk together the eggs, milk, flour, 1/4 teaspoon salt, 1/4 teaspoon pepper, and the chopped spinach leaves until smooth.

Pour the egg mixture over the vegetables and bake at 400°F for 25-30 minutes, until the vegetables are tender and the egg mixture is set. Serve immediately.

Note: If you want a creamier egg mixture, you can add an extra 1/4 cup milk.
